Terrific Threes meet two or three days per week, either Tuesdays and Thursdays or Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from 9am to 11:30am.
(class ratios 8:1)

Our Fantastic Fours

Fantastic Fours meet three days per week on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9am to 11:30am.
(class ratios 10:1)

Epiphany Lutheran Preschool provides a loving, Christian environment of learning and socialization for children ages 2 ½



through 5. The ELP program continues to grow in number, but we are committed to keeping our class sizes very small.

Epiphany Lutheran Preschool views children and families as a precious resource, given by God. Through our Preschool, we have the opportunity to provide a Christian atmosphere and stimulating environment in which children may grow in knowledge and love of God as well as physically, socially, emotionally, and intellectually.

WHAT WE BELIEVE

During the first five years of life, children grow and learn rapidly. They are like little sponges, soaking up all the information that comes in through their senses. They get all this information by being inquisitive, independent, and lovingly guided. We believe children learn best by doing and by being actively involved.

WHAT WE DO

In an attractive and well-planned environment, our qualified, Christian teachers guide and stimulate the children's natural curiosity and initiative. In our school, children are allowed the needed space and materials to play, to work, to discuss, to listen, to think and to create.

Epiphany Lutheran Preschool provides 2-5 day per week morning programs for 2 ½, 3, 4 and 5 year olds. In our equipped space in the lower level of the church building, we learn, play, and learn how to get along with others.

Our program offers extracurricular activities through weekly Spanish lessons and bi-weekly Bodies in Motion gym classes. These programs are taught by educators in that field and our students thrive on learning about another language and culture and by strengthening their bodies through structured gym time.



Through our relationship with local kindergartens and other parochial Preschools, ELP strives to help develop "teachable children" - two, three, four and five year olds with the social skills and receptivity to learning that will enable them to maximize their potential in whatever school they attend.
